









The Banca Desk was originally designed as a meeting table in a Bank; “Bank” coming from the medieval Italian “Banca”, referring to the bench over which money was exchanged.

With this important roll the Banca needed to be both formal but plain.

It’s key feature is it’s beautiful extended finger joints that connect the legs to the table top. A detail inspired by JKMM ‘s Viikki Church.

Not only is this joint immensely strong and easy to make but it also becomes decoration; a feature akin to the triglyph of a doric frieze.
